Entry Fees: Dressage \$35 /class, CT \$65 /division, limit 4 classes per rider.

Refunds: No refunds after closing date, refunds less \$20 office fee before closing date

Awards: 8 ribbons/division

Starting Times: Will be emailed and posted on the Heartland Region Pony Club Facebook page and Startbox

Stabling: Permanent stabling on grounds, limited, Reserve in advance \$35/night beginning at noon on Friday. Tack stalls may be limited. Stalls must be cleaned at the end of the show. Bedding available \$10 pre-ordered, limited supply on grounds.

NEW OPTIONAL STALL CLEANING FEE:** \$20 fee to have your stall cleaned for you at the end of the show.

Campsites: Reservation must be included with entry. \$25/night

Dressage Tests: CT-2022 USEF Eventing tests; Dressage: 2023 USEF tests, small sand arena, training level and above may use large arena, USEF Level 1 - 3 tests will use large arena; Western Dressage: WDAA 2022 tests.
