### NON-QUALIFYING New Jersey Pony Club - 2024 Dressage Rally

Open to all members of all ages and certification levels

We hope you will find the entry process with Blue Horse Entries more convenient and time efficient. A few notes about creating your entry.

- If you haven't already, you will need to create an account and add your horse (s) with Blue Horse Entries.
- If you are entering your child, please create an account and then follow verification instructions before you can add your child's information. This only takes a few minutes.
- Proof of negative Coggins and USET liability form are required and can be uploaded directly to your account on Blue Horse. Your entry is not considered complete until we have both of these documents. DC's must submit Coaches forms to secretaries prior to the day of the event. All documents must be received by April 22.
- When entering, please indicate your CLUB NAME in the "Pony Club Affiliation" and "Team Name" sections.
- For Regular Qualifying Riders ONLY, if signing up for a Regular Qualifying test you must

also register for a Freestyle or Pas de Deux.

- All riders, please indicate your tests of choice in the notes/special requests box on the final page of your entry.
- PLEASE REVIEW THE TEST DESCRIPTIONS LISTED TO DETERMINE WHAT TEST TO ENTER. ALL TESTS HAVE AN OPTION FOR JR & SR DIVISIONS.

#### \*\*Here is how to get a minor added to Blue Horse Entries\*\*

- 1. Under profile settings, click on the Rider Under 18 tab.
- 2. Complete a brief, one-time ID verification process that enhances security and safety by ensuring accuracy of parent and guardian information.
- 3. Click to add a rider under 18 and add their details.
- 4. Once saved to an account, when they go to register for an event, they will select either themselves or their child as the rider on the first step of the entry process.



### Qualifying Rally (Regular and Modified Champs)

#### Who may qualify:

- **Regular Champs** C1 or higher, 12 years of older
- Modified Champs D2 or higher, 10 years or older

Arena: Tests will be ridden in the large (20m x 60m) area

<u>Time Schedule:</u> 7 a.m. - Trailers may begin arriving 8 a.m. - Rally officially begins 8:20 a.m. - HM briefing (Stable closes to parents at 8:15 a.m.) 8:45 a.m. - Jogs for participants Participant ride times will be assigned in advance of the rally Award ceremony to follow final rider's submission

Tests: Please enter according to the list below. Please indicate your chosen tests on entry.

- REGULAR Qualifying Champs C1 Riding or higher JR & SR Division
  Choose Test #2 and Test #3 at Training Fourth Level
- REGULAR Qualifying Champs Freestyle-C1 Riding or higher JR & SR Division
- REGULAR Qualifying Champs Pas de Deux C1 Riding or higher JR & SR Division
- MODIFIED Qualifying Champs D2 Riding or higher JR & SR Division
  - Choose Test #1 and Test #2 at Training Fourth Level

\*\*\*Regular Qualifying Champs competitors will ride Test #2 and #3 at their chosen level and must enter either a Freestyle or a Pas de Deux.

\*\*\*Modified Champs competitors will only ride Test #1 and Test #2 at their chosen level

#### **Championships Eligibility Requirements:**

- For Modified Training Level—Complete a standard or modified Dressage rally at the competition level and earn a minimum score of 55% on Test 2.
- For Regular Training Level—Complete Test 2, Test 3, and a musical freestyle at standard Dressage rally at the competition level. Earn a minimum score of 60% on Test 3.
- For Modified First Level and Up- Complete a standard or modified Dressage rally at the competition level and earn a minimum score of 55% on Test 2.
- First Level and Up— Complete Test 2, Test 3, and a musical freestyle at standard Dressage rally at the competition level. Earn a minimum score of 60% on Test 3.



# **Non-Qualifying Rally:**

Who may qualify: This rally is open to all members of all ages and certification levels.

Arena: Tests will be ridden in the small (20m x 40m) area

<u>Time Schedule</u>: 11 a.m. – Participants to arrive 12 p.m. – Stable area will be closed to parents 12:15 p.m. – HM briefing Specific ride times will be assigned in advance of the rally Award ceremony to follow the competition of the final ride

<u>Tests</u>: Tests from Intro A (walk/trot) to Training Test #3 may be ridden. For Western Dressage, tests from Intro Level Test #1 to Basic Level Test #1 may be ridden. You must choose two and only the following test combinations are permitted:

- Intro A/Intro B JR & SR Division
- Intro B/Intro C JR & SR Division
- Intro C/Training 1 JR & SR Division
- Training 1/Training 2 JR & SR Division
- Training 2/Training 3 JR & SR Division
- Western Intro 1/Western Intro 2 JR & SR Division
- Western Intro 2/Western Intro 3 JR & SR Division
- Western Intro 3/Western Intro 4 JR &SR Division
- Western Intro 4/Western Basic 1 JR & SR Division

\*\*Leadline option for Intro A and B\*\*

\*\*Non-Qualifying riders can have dressage test readers.\*\*
