Open to all members of all certification levels and ages.

Entry Guidelines and Tips:

- Junior Division is for Under Age 18, Senior Division is for 18+. (Use age as of Jan 1.)
- Please put your CLUB NAME in the "Pony Club Affiliation" and "Team Name" sections.
- Current proof of negative Coggins and a USET liability form are required and have to be uploaded directly to your account on Blue Horse. Your entry is not considered complete until we have both.
- Remember to indicate your tests of choice in the special requests box on the final page.
- Registering a Junior who is under 18? Here is how to add a Minor to Blue Horse Entries:
 - Under profile settings, click on the Rider Under 18 tab.
 - Complete a brief, one-time ID verification process that enhances security and safety by ensuring accuracy of parent and guardian information.
 - Click to add a rider under 18 and add the Minor's details.
 - Once a Minor is saved to your account, you may enter either yourself or a minor on your account as the rider on the first step of the entry process.

Recent Changes **There is no modified Qualifying this year! All Qualifying riders ride Tests 2 and 3!**
Pony Club has newer requirements for safety equipment. One of these changes means use of peacock stirrups is no longer allowed. Please review all updated information to ensure your equipment is still ok to use.

QUALIFYING RALLY DETAILS

Who may ride:

This rally is for members who are looking to qualify for Champs.

Division Level	Age	Certification
Junior Training Level	10-17	D-2
Senior Training Level	18+	DR/EV/EV1/
Junior First Level & Up	10-17	HSE/WST/
Senior First Level & Up	18+	WDR

Stable managers must meet the minimum age and certification criteria of their division.

Please see full details in the Dressage or Western Dressage Rulebooks, especially Article 31—Championships Divisions—Minimum Age and Certifications

Arena:

Tests will be ridden in the large (20m x 60m) area

Tests:

All Qualifying competitors will ride Test #2 and #3 at their chosen level from Training Level to Fourth level. Additionally, they may add a Musical Freestyle or Pas de Deux.

Championships Eligibility Requirement Highlights related to Rallies:

Each individual Pony Club member who desires to compete at Championships must compete in a regional rally and be judged at the minimum HM level and same competition level in which they intend to compete at Championships. This constitutes the “individual eligibility” of the competitor.

Complete a Dressage rally completing Tests 2 and 3 at the competition level you are entering at Championships. Earn a minimum score of 55% on Test 3.

NON QUALIFYING RALLY DETAILS

Who may ride:

This rally is open to all members of all ages and certification levels.

Arena:

Tests will be ridden in the small arena (20m x 40m)

Tests:

For Dressage, USDF tests from Intro A to Training 3 may be ridden.

For Western Dressage, WDAA tests from Intro 1 to Basic 1 may be ridden.

Ride two consecutive tests of your choice.

This allows the following combinations to be ridden:

NON-QUALIFYING Dressage Intro A/B

NON-QUALIFYING Dressage Intro B/C

NON-QUALIFYING Dressage Intro C/Training 1

NON-QUALIFYING Dressage Training 1/Training 2

NON-QUALIFYING Dressage Training 2/Training 3

NON-QUALIFYING Western Dressage Intro 1/Intro 2

NON-QUALIFYING Western Dressage Intro 2/Intro 3

NON-QUALIFYING Western Dressage Intro 3/Intro 4

NON-QUALIFYING Western Dressage Intro 4/Basic 1

There will be different Junior and Senior Divisions.

Non-Qualifying riders who need special approval for non-standard bits should email

Leadline optional for Dressage Intro A and Intro B, plus Western Dressage Intro 1 and Intro 2.

Non-Qualifying riders CAN have dressage test readers.
