COMBINED TESTS: USEA Medical Armbands required for Stadium jumping. (www.useventing.com)

MEDICAL RELEASES: Riders under the age of 18 must have an entry form and medical release signed by parent or guardian, if not accompanied by parent.

RIDE TIMES: Posted no later than Wednesday, August 3rd at www.HorseAidLive.org

AWARDS: Prizes 1st Place. Ribbons 1st-6th Place.

STABLING: Limited stalls \$25/day. Straw ONLY allowed by park and not available at show. Stalls MUST be stripped at completion of show. Separate stall deposit check of \$50 must accompany entry if needing stall which will be shredded or returned when stall is stripped. (Stabling should only be paid to Kentucky Dressage Association if showing on Sunday, August 2.)

ATTIRE: Approved helmets and footwear required. Coats and braiding not required.

FOOD & DRINK: Available on grounds 7:00 am - 4:00 pm with coffee/breakfast and lunch.
